



1. Educators Employment Liability (EEL) Coverage

Provides up to \$1 million in damages assessed against you as a result of civil suits brought while you are/were a college student in a teaching or related activity as required by your educational program.

2. Scholarships

Student PSEA members are eligible to compete for scholarship money through the PSEA Lucy A. Valero Scholarship and the NEA-Retired Jack Kinnaman Scholarship.



3. Networking

Share ideas, concerns, successes, fears, and job leads with student members from across the state and nation. Start building relationships with active local leaders... relationships that may be helpful when job seeking!

4. Grant Opportunities

Student PSEA chapters can apply for up to \$1,000 to fund local community outreach efforts through NEA's CLASS Grants (Community Learning Through America's Schools). Student Organizing Assistance and Resources (SOAR) Grants are also available for membership recruitment.

5. Professional Development

Learn about new strategies and methods for teaching and share tips that you have learned along the way. Hear from new and veteran teachers about the issues facing public education and classroom teachers.
