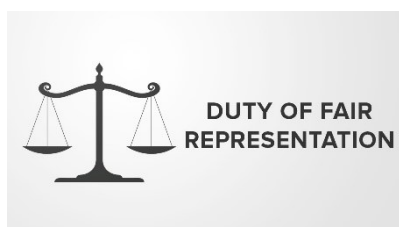


What is DFR...and Is It Important?
