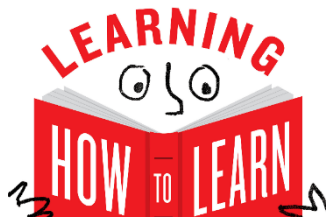


Empowered Learning*
