Understanding and Supporting LGBTQ+ Students
Presenter: Gina Gullo, PSEA Asst. Director of Ed Services


Educators increasingly express challenges in meeting the growing needs of the students they serve. For some, this includes a need to understand identities, specific terminology, and strategies to support LGBTQIA+ students and communities. This session focuses on providing a basic knowledge of and resources related to each of these elements. Participants can expect to learn: (1) differences between sex, gender, and orientation; (2) basic terminology used by many to express identities within the LGBTQIA+ community; (3) basic strategies to support LGBTQIA+ youth; and (4) where to find additional resources to support educators in supporting LGBTQIA+ youth. While this course is designed to meet the needs of all educators, content might be most beneficial to pupil services educators and teachers of adolescents.

This session will explore what role Trauma plays in child development as well as possible long term impacts on students as they grow to adulthood. The session will begin with a look at the seminal study which linked Childhood Trauma and Adverse Childhood Experiences to later life onset of chronic disease. The program will then shift to what we can do as Support Staff and/or Professional Educators today to minimize the impact of childhood trauma as well as what services are available for those who have already experienced such trauma. The program will also look at "Positive Childhood Experiences" as a means to mitigate ACE's.
