Course #3639 (2 hours) Best Practice of Online Learning

This course will explore the best practices for online learning as per the iNacol standards and Universal design for learning (UDL) guidelines. We will discuss each standard and identify how educational technology tools can be used to enhance these practices through free and easy to use educational technology tools. Afterwards participants will have time to discuss and brainstorm ways they can use educational technology in an upcoming lesson.

This course will help educators understand the why and how when it comes to educational technology in the classroom (hybrid, traditional, and online) spaces. At the end of the course, participants will spend some time working on an upcoming lesson, and we will discuss how educational technology can be used to connect that lesson with their students.

We will explore specific tools such as peardeck, canva for educators, wakelet, loom, teachermade, and wizer. Some teachers might already have accounts from their school entities. Participants who do not have a free educational account should register for one prior to the event.
