As we see situations in classrooms with different stakeholder groups escalating quickly around social issues, it is becoming apparent that teachers are struggling as they are navigating these issues within their classrooms. To be more aware of how you are being equitable and adjusting

your classroom to address implicit bias issues could become overwhelming to the point of causing racial anxiety. In addition, minority groups at the same time could be functioning with racial anxiety as they navigate the norms of systems. Using several articles to describe racial anxiety, we will lead a facilitated discussion around this topic to have people share their experiences to help navigate future experiences and feelings.
