## BEGINNING TO TEACH MICRO-CREDENTIALS FROM EDUCATORS RISING

As students develop teaching skills, they deserve recognition for their growth. Micro-credentials are performance-based assessments in which rising educators can demonstrate the skills they've developed, showcased via a digital badge.

The five Educators Rising *Beginning to Teach* micro-credentials are available to all preservice educators. Anyone interested in taking the first steps on the path to accomplished teaching can build portfolios to submit for these micro-credentials through our partner, Digital Promise.

Each Educators Rising micro-credential submission requires an estimated 5-15 hours of work. Submissions are reviewed by expert educators, ensuring that achieving a micro-credential represents a meaningful early step on the path to accomplished teaching. Educators Rising is working with institutions of higher education, scholarship committees, employers, and other evaluators to recognize and value micro-credential achievement.

The *Beginning to Teach* micro-credential stack was updated in April 2025 to align with updates to the Educators Rising Curriculum for the upcoming 2025-2026 school year.
