

Tips/Guidance for 10-Minute Member Meeting on ESSA (tailored for Local Leaders with CSI or A-TSI schools)

General Materials Needed	Room Set-up
 Invitation to the meeting (sent in advance) via email, flier Invite members to a 10-minute meeting to learn how ESSA creates opportunities for us to make positive changes for our schools; Encourage members to BYOD (bring their own device – smartphone, etc.) to complete the NEA Opportunity Checklist Handouts Opportunity Checklist (hard copy/one-pager) ESSA 101: Slide Deck Contact sheet of the Local Association members serving as core team/ resource on ESSA/school improvement for the local (if applicable). Point of Contact Cards 	Be sure to have access to Wi-Fi and have the password if needed

But only if we get engaged. Encourage folks to take time after the meeting and review the ESSA 101 slide deck and share their questions and suggestions. If the Local Association has already identified a core team of members to engage in school improvement work on behalf of the local, this would be a good time to introduce them to the members in attendance.
