The role of a paraeducator in the classroom has grown significantly in the last ten years. This training will instruct on educational practices and expand upon information that should be provided to you as the paraeducator working with students in the classroom. We will also expound on effective communication techniques when working with students, parents, and other colleagues to help you to feel comfortable as you discuss difficult topics about student behaviors and progress.

In addition, we will also answer questions about different things that you are asked to do in the classroom so that you are able to do your best work for the students for which you work with and to also feel like you are using appropriate educational practices to handle those situations.
