The Collective Bargaining Process Under the Law

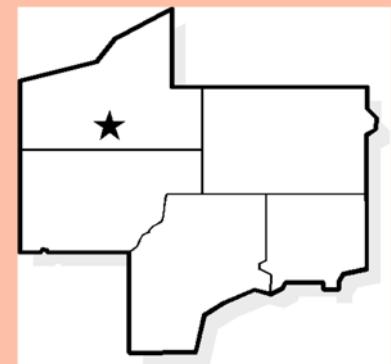
