## HEALTHY

Each student enters school healthy and learns about and practices a healthy lifestyle.

*Band Aids (NON LATEX), cotton balls, ice packs (crack & shake), sunscreen, sun visors or sun hats.*



Each student learns in an environment that is physically and emotionally safe for students and adults.
