WHEREAS, by identifying and utilizing community resources to enhance and complement comprehensive counseling programs, counselors help students develop relationships and skills that will serve them well throughout their lives; and

WHEREAS, parents collaborate with school counselors to further the educational, social, and emotional growth of their children; and

WHEREAS, school counselors are vital members of a successful educational team, working with teachers, administrators, support staff, and the community to ensure the well-being of Pennsylvania's children.
