Planning to Retire? With PSERS, You're on Your Way!

he Public School Employees' Retirement System (PSERS) offers free in-person and online small group Retirement Exit Counseling sessions to every PSERS member who is ready to retire. Counseling sessions are for every member, regardless of position.

If you plan to retire within the next 12 months, contact PSERS at 1-888-773-7748 to request a staff-prepared estimate before scheduling your counseling session. A Request for Retirement Estimate (PSRS-151) form is also available on the PSERS website (*psers.pa.gov*) and in the Member Self-Service Portal.

At these meetings, you'll receive personal assistance from a PSERS Retirement Representative in reviewing your PSERS staff-prepared retirement estimate, Application for Retirement (PSRS-8), PSERS group health insurance, and when and how your retirement benefit will begin. Their

sessions are designed to help you avoid making mistakes that may permanently impact your retirement benefit.

Keep in mind: To retain a retirement date of the day following your termination date, you must file your Application for Retirement within 90 days of your termination date.

PSERS is available to answer questions and assist its members in taking this first step toward retirement. PSERS staff look forward to hearing from you.
