Tobacco, Nicotine & Vaping: Prevention and Treatment (WILL be recorded) Tobacco, Nicotine & Vaping

 Nicotine products have changed, but many of the industry tactics to encourage new tobacco users to start have not. Participants will learn about the different tobacco and nicotine products, health impacts, and how the vaping epidemic transpired. Participants will also learn about programs, resources, and strategies to prevent vaping, and help young people and adults to quit.
