



Associate Staff Counsel

PSEA is looking to fill a full-time, temporary attorney position. The "Associate Staff Counsel" position is located in **Allentown, PA** and extends for two years, with a possible third year.

The Associate Staff Counsel position is similar to a labor and/or education law internship. The attorney will perform legal research and writing, and support the PSEA Legal Division in advising PSEA on matters of statewide and organizational significance. In addition, this position supports attorneys who are litigating cases. Interested applicants should have an interest in labor and/or education law, have strong legal research and writing skills, and be able to analyze complex legal issues and prepare legal memoranda, briefs and pleadings as assigned by the attorneys. These individuals must also have self-supporting computer skills.

PSEA is looking for someone who is willing to make a two to three year commitment. This position will be vacant in the Fall of 2019. This position offers a salary of approximately \$62,600 and a comprehensive benefits package. Admission to the PA Bar is preferred for consideration for this position and is required after the first admission date after employment.
